Garden State Chapter Member of the Month

Richard Kirk



Mr. Richard (Rick) Kirk has been in the logistics support business for over 41 years. He arrived at Ft. Monmouth in July 1969 and started as a maintenance engineer. From late 1969 to 1971, he completed his active duty tour from ROTC (Ft Huachuca and Viet Nam) and returned to Ft. Monmouth to resume his maintenance engineer duties for the AN/VRC-12 and the developmental SHF TACSAT family. He moved to the US Army SATCOMA to become the overall ILS manager for the SHF TACSAT through its R&D, LRIP and production phases. The SHF TACSAT was a key system in the conceptual change of soldiers becoming combined operator/maintainers.

Mr. Kirk moved back to CECOM in 1984 to become the division chief (one of the few GS-14 division chiefs) of the recently created Provisioning Parts Identification and Documentation Division with its 90-115 provisioning specialists. While in that division, he conceived and implemented the merger

of the provisioning and cataloging functional personnel into one division. Mr. Kirk has been a branch chief in the Plans and Programs Division and Maintenance Engineering Division and the "teamed" branch within the Logistics and Maintenance Directorate. While in the teamed branch that supported a variety of satellite communications systems, he devised an approach to the RFPs for the SCAMP and SMART-T programs that eliminated over 120 Contract Data Requirements List items; an early example of aggressive acquisition streamlining.

A career-long advocate of education, training and personnel development, Mr. Kirk has participated in the development of ALMC courses and their "pilot" offerings and, more recently, participated in intern training at Ft Monmouth.

Currently, Mr. Kirk is the chief of the provisioners and technical writers in the Tactical Radio Branch in the Product Lifecycle Management Division of the Communications Directorate.

Mr. Kirk is a graduate of Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute with a BSEE and Fairleigh Dickenson University with a MSEE. He lives in Lincroft (hates long commutes), is married to Janet for almost 40 years, has two sons and four grandchildren. When not doing home projects, he keeps active playing roller hockey and, according to his wife, spending way too much time playing Magic: the Gathering.
